 - a. Climbing frame and Multiplay look at safety surface it has been highlighted that due to the risk of fall from height (more than 2m) then the surface needs to be relaid or replaced.
 - b. Jungle Gym look at the eyelet fixings 50% worn and will need to be replaced soon.
 - c. Flat disk springer safety surface inadequate, slippery requires replacing.
